We are less than 170 days to the Canada Winter Games!

The Selection Camp for the U16 Mens' Hockey Team will be September 24th 25th and 26th.

The Selection Camp will include the following:

The **fee** for the selection camp is \$75.00

- **fitness testing** by Jake Jirousek on **Thursday September 23rd** at 202 Falcon Your player will have a scheduled time between 4:00 and 7:00 P.M.

- on ice skills testing again with Jake **Friday September 24th between 6:30 A.M. and 8:00 A.M.** This will be a short test and again you will have a scheduled time

Independent evaluators, including a hockey individual from out of Yukon will be provided with the fitness testing results and will observe the three on ice sessions.

The following players will not be in attendance at the Selection Camp however they are eligible to be considered for Team Yukon. We have confirmed their eligibility with YAHA, the Chef de Mission of Team Yukon and the Canada Games Council. These players have all recently competed in rigorous tryout processes outside of the territory and are playing at the Bantam AAA or Midget AA level and are considered selected to the Development Team.

Following the selection camp a Development Team of up to 25 players will be named.

Development Team EXPECTATIONS

The Canada Winter Games is not just another hockey tournament... Players are representing the Yukon and we want to send the very best prepared and skilled team we can.

The following expectations are **MANDATORY**. Any player not meeting the expectations as set out will not be named to the 20 Member Team Yukon Canada Winter Games Squad (named in January 2011)

Those players outside of the territory will be monitored for their team code of conduct, level of play and commitment to their team training.

Yukon players

There will be

- two dryland sessions per week

- one ice time (practice)

As the U16 players are divided between Bantam and Midget leagues it is also expected that all members of the Development team are also playing on the rep team for their category.

Coaching and Management Staff will be establishing two out of territory tournaments for the CWG Development Team.

A code of conduct will be established for this team including school attendance and maintaining an academic standard which all players are expected to observe.

Again, the final roster of 20 players for the Canada Winter Games team will not be named until January 2011- after the tournaments.

The Canada Winter Games will require a focused dedication your player may not have experienced before. It is also an amazing special opportunity. Please consider all of these points and advise me via e-mail if your player will be registering for the Selection Camp. I will not require an additional form to be completed- simply an e-mail indicating your desire to register for the selection camp and how you will making payment.

If you choose not to register please advise me via e-mail to ensure I do not schedule your player for the fitness testing.

The Selection Camp will be publicly advertised for those individuals who may have just moved to the Yukon. If you have received this e-mail and responded you do not have to register with Sport Yukon.

I will send out an additional e-mail with information regarding the announcement of the development squad (how this will be done), ice times and the financial costs associated with this team.
